



Tiger Aquatics Locker Room Policy

Tiger Aquatics uses the locker rooms at each of its practice facilities and at destination meets hosted by other clubs/entities. Locker rooms are utilized for changing before and after practices and meets. We follow the guidelines of the individual sites as well as the guidelines of USA Swimming.

Any form of physical/sexual/emotional abuse, threats, bullying, harassment, and hazing is strictly prohibited in any Tiger Aquatics function, including in locker room areas. Tiger Aquatics swimmers, coaches, parents, and volunteers will be subject to disciplinary action for any violation of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP) and/or Tiger Aquatics policies.

Use of cell phones or any other mobile recording devices (inclusive of voice recording, still camera, and video camera) increases the risk for different forms of misconduct in locker rooms. Therefore, the use of these devices is strictly prohibited in locker rooms or any other changing area.

Any level of perceived misbehavior in locker rooms should be reported to a Tiger Aquatics coach, board member, or the Safe Sport Coordinator.

Investigation of such allegations could lead to a range of disciplinary measures in accordance with policy, including suspension of locker room usage.

Random monitoring of locker rooms or other changing areas by Tiger Aquatics coaches (in accordance with USA Swimming policy) may occur to help discourage locker room misbehavior as needed.
