



Tiger Aquatics Parents Code of Conduct [2025]

The purpose of this code of conduct for parents is to establish common expectations for behavior by parents. Parents recognize the important growth and developmental support that their child's participation fosters and that it is essential to provide the coaching staff with the respect and authority to coach the team. By enrolling their children in Tiger Aquatics offerings, parents agree to:

- Set the right example for our child athletes by demonstrating sportsmanship and showing respect and common courtesy at all times to the team members, coaches, competitors, officials, parents, and all facilities.
- Get involved by volunteering, observing practices according to coach guidelines, cheering at meets, and talking constructively with their child and coach about their progress.
- Refrain from coaching from the stands (their own children or others') during practices and meets.
- Understand that criticizing, name-calling, use of abusive language or gestures directed at anyone during practices/meets will not be tolerated.
- Respect the integrity of the officials.
- Direct any concerns to their child's direct coach, and then, if not satisfied, to the appropriate supervisor up to and including the head coach. Non-coaching concerns may also be directed to any member of the board of directors.

Any complaints of parent violations of this code filed with the coaching staff, the Safe Sport Coordinator, or the board of directors will be addressed directly with the parent in question.
